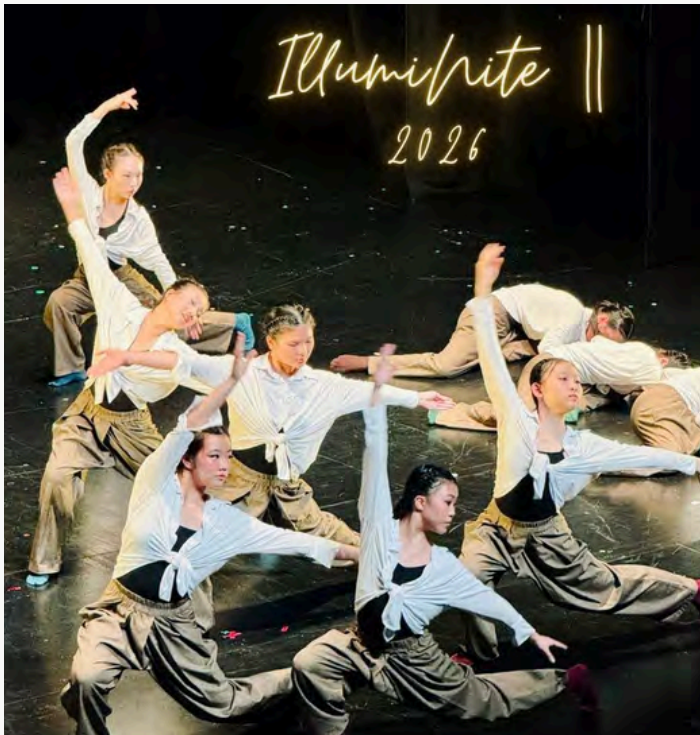




Igniting the Spark Within

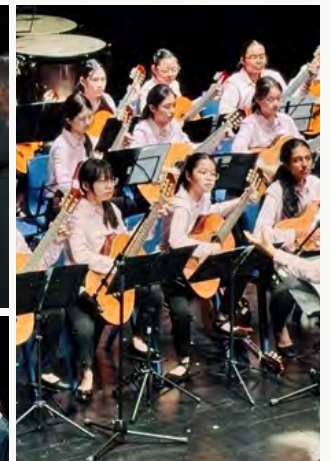
From the Editor's desk

During Learning Week, students gained fresh perspectives through interdisciplinary learning journeys at the Singapore River and the National Gallery, discovering how the Humanities, Science and Art connect in understanding Singapore's story. Students also stretched their creativity through Code for Fun, Interactive drama and Public Speaking workshops, as well as the Music Alive concert, where performers wowed their peers with lively performances. Beyond academic enrichment sessions, students stepped out of their comfort zones through sports activities such as archery, inline skating and rope skipping. Student-planned class bonding sessions also brought plenty of laughter, teamwork and unforgettable memories. Secondary 3 students connected meaningfully with the community through VIA activities with seniors, while ECG programmes and networking sessions with professionals sparked ideas about future aspirations. Our Secondary 4 and 5 students impressed their peers and teachers at the Passion Ignite Showcase, confidently sharing projects and hobbies they had been developing over the past few months.

Total Defence Day Commemoration

With the theme, "Together We Keep Singapore Strong," Total Defence Day 2026 served as a reminder that readiness and resilience are shared responsibilities.
